



ES determine if it's worth encouraging a training provider to join the ETPL

DEED staff verify with MOHE that a training provider is licensed, registered, or exempt before placing a training provider on the ETPL

**FYI:** If a training institution has no physical location in MN, and the program it offers is WIOA-approved by the state in which the institution is located, MN will consider that program WIOA-approved, but will not list the program or institution on the Minnesota ETPL. \*Placed documentation in file

If the funding source for the training changes (e.g. state funds to National Emergency Grant), DEED will require the ES to change the funding categorization to meet federal requirements. DEED strongly encourages use of WIOA-approved training to ensure maximum flexibility in the event of funding stream changes.

An ES may use WIOA funds to provide training in programs or courses that are not WIOA-approved as long as the ES verifies the training provider is MOHE licensed, registered, or exempt. However, this training **will not count** towards a credential (non-credentialed training activity)
