 - Duplication of work may initially occur—Executive Internal Operations Group (made up of each work group's Chair) to review, as appropriate
 - How strategic work groups efforts and achievements will be shared publicly is to be determined

c. Carver County Updates

- Economic/Workforce Development Round Tables
 - i. 1st roundtable discussion occurred- focusing on workforce business matching and how to enhance local economy—each meeting will have a presentation, discuss how to bring local businesses together and fill jobs with career seekers



- Community/Technical College Partnerships
 - i. Hennepin Technical College: Tabling to recruit and provide information
 - ii. Normandale Community College: Virtual information sent to recruit and provide information
- Work with Libraries- Update
 - Resume workshops; youth for job opportunities (child and young literacy to driver overall efforts)
- Partnership with Launch Ministries: Wellness, Employment and Education Program "Coffee Shop"
 - i. Carver County will be using the coffee shop as a training group for young adults (up to age 28); 6-9 months with a focus on coaching, wellness, long-term training and moving into a coffee shop setting (skill building, tools, resume development, etc.) and result in graduating from coffee shop
 - Nationally recognized model
- d. Hennepin County Updates
 - Flexible Money- Innovative and responsive to community needs
 - i. Roster Program: \$6 million of pandemic recovery dollars; currently working on sector-based Career Pathways Program/RFPs
 - ii. Library RFP: Select provider to provide services for individuals in library
 - **iii.** Be @ School Program: Youth experiencing educational truancy- attaching workforce component
 - iv. **Project HOPE**: Partnership with Sherriff's Department and Department of Corrections on probation and/or exiting facilities to support with employment
 - v. Security Officer Pathway Program: Hennepin County as an employer; employer partner with post-secondary solutions to help provide services and prepare individuals for the training and on the job experience
 - vi. Non-Custodial Parent Pathway: Prevent default on child support and losing access to resources (ex: driver's license)
